RUM GO OVERVIEW

RUM GO was G3 placed as a 2 year old in the Jessamine Stakes at Keeneland. Looking back, the winner of the Jessamine was La Coronel, arguably the best 3 year old turf filly in the crop with SW Lull right in front of Rum Go, finishing 2nd. She went off form this winter but returned with a huge race at Indiana Grand going one mile on the turf for new trainer Brad Cox in May, earning an impressive 89 Beyer. She came out of the race in top form and after breezing a bullet two weeks later, Brad put her right back in the Wild Applause Stakes (3 ½ weeks later) in New York. The race rained off the turf and the owners wanted to run in the four horse field, she tailed off on dirt as the even money favorite. Sending her back to turf will send her new owners to the winners circle and on to Stakes races this summer.

She earned 89 Beyer, 7.5 Thoro-Graph, and 12.25 Ragozin in her WIN on May 31st.

CURRENT TRAINER – BRAD COX

Brad Cox has been on a rapid rise since he started training in 2007. This year alone his horses have won over \$6 million. He has bases in KY, NY, LA, and Arkansas. He has not been labeled for training one type of horse, rather wins at a high percentage with all types. He keeps his horses in excellent condition and would love to have this filly back in his barn for the new owners.

RACE CAREER OVERVIEW

JUNE 24TH – WILD APPLAUSE STAKES

FINISHED 4TH AFTER PROMPTING PACE – () WATCH RACE REPLAY (SHE IS #1)

With the race scheduled for one mile on the turf, **RUM GO** figured to be very competitive in her return to stakes company. Heavy rains forced the race to the dirt, and **RUM GO** was kept in the race even though her trainer thought she had no chance to win. She was made the even money betting choice by the public. She broke fine but was quickly distanced, running like a horse hating the surface. Draw a line through this effort, this daughter of Mizzen Mast isn't one for the mud.

MAY 31ST – ALLOWANCE

WON BY 2 LENGTHS - () WATCH RACE REPLAY (SHE IS #6)

Was given 8 weeks between races after she was moved to new trainer Brad Cox, the clockers raved about her moves in the AM, with the public making her 2-1 off a poor effort at the Fair Grounds. She did not disappoint with a huge turn of foot to win going away. The TDN explained it best:

"**RUM GO** graduated second out in her turf debut Aug. 4 at Delaware and ran a third at over 84-1 when stepped up into the GIII JPMorgan Chase Jessamine S. Oct. 12. Filling the same slot behind **TDN Rising Star** Stallion Heiress (Exchange Rate) in the Joseph E. Spanky Broussard Memorial S. Feb. 11 at Fair Grounds, she was seventh when last seen there Mar. 27 in her final start for the Tom Proctor barn. Made the 11-5 second choice in this spot, the gray settled in third behind a runaway pace-setter through splits of :23.59 and :47.56. Inching within two lengths of the front at the top of the far turn, she burst through a seam turning for home and drew clear to score over favored Cha Cha Magic (Mizzen Mast) by two lengths. The winner's dam is responsible for a juvenile Eskendereya filly named Eskenforadrink and was bred to Magna Graduate last spring. Lifetime Record: GSP, 6-2-0-2, \$59,850."

OCTOBER 12TH, 2016 – G3 JESSAMINE STAKES

FINISHED A GAME 3RD - 🕟 WATCH RACE REPLAY (SHE IS #10)

Was coming off a MSW win at Delaware, but had no love on the tote board in a full field of 12 in the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" G3 at Keeneland. She out-ran her odds. She broke well but was inexplicably sent 4 wide on the first turn. She continued to travel 4 wide on the far turn with both the 1-2 finishers saving all the ground inside of her. When the final running started, she was one paced late and tired. Although she was beat 6 lengths, she had a VERY wide trip. According to the Trakus chart below, she covered 47 feet (approx 6 lengths) more than the winner!


