SIEM RIEP

OVERVIEW

SIEM RIEP won his turf debut and 2nd lifetime start on June 10th with ease in a Maiden Special Weight at Monmouth Park going 1 1/16M on the Turf. He is very lightly raced, and appears to be on his way to Stakes company anywhere in the Country.

In two lifetime starts he finished 6th in a Maiden originally scheduled for the turf but moved to the sloppy main track at Pimlico and won a Maiden going 1 mile on the turf on June 10th. Trainer Christophe Clement always thought he was better on turf, hence having entered him on it in his career debut.

He earned an 82 Beyer, 10 Thoro-Graph, and 12 Ragozin in his win on June 10th.

CURRENT TRAINER - CHRISTOPHE CLEMENT

Christophe has been one of the leading trainers for the last 20 years in New York. While he continues to win at around 20% each year, he is very kind to his horses. His vet bills are minimal, and he gives horses the time when needed. He maintains Siem Riep is very clean and has never been injected or had any performance enhancing procedures performed.

RACE CAREER OVERVIEW

JUNE 10TH - MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT

WON BY 2 ½ LENGTHS - ▶ WATCH RACE REPLAY (HE IS #5)

In a field of 8 at Monmouth Park, **SIEM RIEP** went off at 4-1 odds. He had a Chad Brown shipper at 3-5 odds to compete with. He was rank early, running a very swift :22.62 opening ¼. Once in front, he settled down to run :46.90 for the half mile. Turning for home he kicked clear showing a very nice turn of foot winning by 2 ½ lengths. Nik Juarez had him in a hand ride down the stretch only showing him the whip a few times but hand riding to the wire. Chad Brown's 3-5 Wanztbwicked ran his race finishing 2nd but just not showing the class or turn of foot Siem Riep showed. The track announcer exclaimed, "Siem Riep strides out nicely to win by 3 ½, and there is more where that came from." It was five lengths back to third place finisher Promethean.

MAY 11TH - MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT

While he ran 6th beaten 7 1/2 lengths in this effort he showed some grit and ability and was 2nd by a head turning for home where he looked like he might get a piece of the race. He failed to fire in the final 1/16th of a mile on a very sloppy surface. This race was scheduled for the turf, came off and he was still made the 3-1 second betting choice based on his solid workout reports. This gave him some good first out experience but trainer Christophe Clement really wanted to get this colt on the turf in his next start

The great part about this horse is he has all his Allowance conditions left. An Alw-1X in New York or California this summer would be the ideal next spot working him into Stakes company with the chance to earn a huge purse (\$90,000 in NY/\$85,000 at Del Mar with the Ship and Win). There is also the option of shipping back to Monmouth to run in the Lamplighter Stakes on July 29th going 1 1/16th miles on the turf. A Stakes Schedule for 3yo turf colts going 2 –turns is below:

PEDIGREE

It is not surprising that SIEM RIEP has found his best stride on turf. His dam AMANSARA won the Without Feathers Stakes on turf by 5 1/4 lengths and went on to run 3rd in the Frances A. Genter Stakes (turf), and 2nd in the always ultracompetitive De La Rose Stakes (turf) at Saratoga. She produced the talented GREY STARK (Tapit) who has been unlucky not to be Stakes Placed on the turf yet. She has earned \$183,000 and her wins include a MSW at Belmont, Allowance at Saratoga, and Allowance at Belmont (by 3 1/4 lengths) all on turf for trainer Chad Brown. She is a beautiful filly that was a \$485,000 yearling purchase.

The turf influences continue through the pedigree with 2nd dam MARIANNA'S GIRL earning \$202k primarily on turf being multiple GSP and Listed Winner. The family also includes G3 winner MARASTANI and CHRISTINE'S OUTLAW both under the second dam with their successes coming on turf as well. It is a deep quality family with many turf influences.
